

**RESOLUTION SETTING CHARGES TO BE COLLECTABLE UNDER
FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP FIRE CHARGES ORDINANCE**

At a regular meeting of the Township Board of Franklin Township, Clare County, Michigan, held at the Township Hall in said Township on the **20th** day of **September, 2012**, at 7:30p.m.

PRESENT: **Supervisor Ecklin, Clerk Blackburn, Treasurer Scherrer, Trustee Dalton & Trustee McLavy**

ABSENT: None

The following Resolution was offered by **Trustee McLavy** and seconded by **Trustee Dalton**.

A. 1945 Public Act 246, as amended (now MCL 41.181 et seq.) authorizes the Township Board to adopt an ordinance regulating the public health, safety, and welfare of persons and property, and fire protection;

B. 1951 Public Act 33, as amended (now MCL 41.801 et seq.) authorizes the Township Board to authorize by ordinance the collection of fees for the service; and

C. Franklin Township contracts with another public entity to provide fire protection services in the Township; and

D. Franklin Township incurs costs and expenses in connection with its procuring fire protection services in the Township; and

E. The Township Board has adopted Ordinance No. **103-12**, the Franklin Township Fire Charges Ordinance, which authorizes the Township to collect various charges for providing fire protection-related services; and

F. Section 3 of that Fire Charges Ordinance requires the Township Board to establish by resolution the amount due for the Township fire department's providing of certain fire protection-related services collectable under the Ordinance; and

G. The Township has considered the appropriate amount of charges that are necessary in order to sustain the maintenance, operation, and feasibility of securing fire protection services in the Township in accordance with and pursuant to standards set forth in the Franklin Township Fire Charge Ordinance and other applicable ordinances, resolutions, or Michigan statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Township Board resolves as follows:

I. The appropriate charges collectable under the Franklin Township Fire Charges Ordinance are as follows: **Five Hundred Dollars (\$500)** for every event that requires a response from either, a Fire Engine, Mini-Pumper Truck, Grass Truck, Water Tank Rig, Jaws of Life, or fire fighter.

II. This resolution is effective upon its publication.

III. This resolution rescinds all prior resolutions inconsistent with this resolution.
