MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: at 6:30 pm. A Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag was said by all.

CLERK'S MINUTES: Minutes looked over and Ecklin made motion to accept with Haley to second Motion carried.

TREASURERS REPORT: General fund balance of \$196,856.52. Road Fund \$424,462.94. Revenue sharing received in the amount of 11K. Ecklin made a motion to accept the Treasurer's report and supported by Haley. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS: Discussion on Republic Waste, Don David spoke about Lincoln sanitation buying old transit building, questions about who keeps republic bins if contract changes, had financial sheet from county administrator, revenue and expenses way up. County wants a 2% raise with bonus, Don is not in favor. Had prelim report on repairs to county building. 150K new roof section, 60K controls for furnace and 58K HVAC need 11 new units and 4 right away. Fitzpatrick taking over maintenance. Road commission spoke about 3 miles of Arnold Lk. needing overlay next year. Rodgers got done but will look at it in the spring for repairs, 6-7 hundred K in road \$ received every year, doing 20 miles of chip and seal in the spring, primary roads rated a 4-7 out of 10, 41 bridges 25' and longer will require 10K in maintenance to keep them in shape, will replace or repair signage, will push brush and tree cutting, John Kirchmeir and Richie Rodgers are retiring, looking to upgrade computer drawing system, if gas tax increases will do equal share match with townships, discussion on trees and ditching on Meredith Grade, will keep township posted on past gravel jobs and how they are holding up, Athey has not been ditched yet, working on solution for waste haulers during frost laws. Mark J. says property on Little George Lake Road has been cleaned up, camper on m18 is back, trouble with recycle dumpster getting here on time, ark will attend solid waste management meeting and find out more, Republic could bring recycle dumpster and empty it when full. Supervisor Erskine says library wants to discuss their side for township \$, Therese will check with Jim Mishler. Elbow Lake Bar wants to know if township will pay for 1/2 of his streetlight as bar closed, Clerk will call MTA for further info. Newsletter done and being sent out with taxes, swore Therese Haley in and election turnout was good.
