CLERKS REPORT: A motion to accept the clerks report with correction was made by Scherrer. Supported by Ecklin. Motion passed.

TREASURERS REPORT: GENERAL FUND: \$447,657.91 RUBBISH FUND: \$78,557.78 ROAD FUND: \$700,995.55

The public revenue sharing check information is \$1064.25 to the county treasurer \$354.75 to the township for public safety. A motion was made by Haley to pay the county. Supported by Ecklin. Motion passed. Members First CD is due in July. A motion to renew the CD was made by Erskine. Supported by Haley. Motion passed. There was a discussion about available phone service to replace AT&T. A motion to pay bills was made by Scherrer. Supported by Ecklin. Motion passed. A motion to accept the treasurers report was made by Haley. Supported by Ecklin. Motion passed.

ROAD COMMISSION: Bill Simpson-Redding township clerk resigned. They need someone to run the election. The county has a lot of black topping going on. The Road Commission hopes to be able to resume work on Forest Rd in July. Some of the cleanup has already been done.

COUNTY COMMISSIONER: David Hoefling-Lansing is giving the county more money. Money will be \$662,759.23 for the lawyer's fund. County Commissioner Majewski is retiring midnight July 3rd.

FRANKLIN ESTATES: need a sign to slow people down on Maple Lane.

BLIGHT OFFICER: Caleb Stenger submitted an email regarding a blight complaint and a residents private dirtbike track. The email was read to the public. Erskine and Stenger have looked into it. The decibels from the track are in acceptable range.

NEW BUSINESS: Trustee Ecklin will call the brine company and request they brine the entire road of Claroskee instead of just part of it. Supervisor Erskine talked about the website. Erie High stated he can update it if the board wishes to keep it. Trustee Haley suggested the board look into the liability insurance. Will revisit this in July. Clerk Schultz requested a pay of \$15 hourly to clean the hall for renting. Only takes 1 hour. Windows and the walls a little longer. A motion to Pay for cleaning was made by Scherrer. Supported by Haley. Motion passed. A resident talked about the 4-H renewal that is on the August ballot. Treasurer Scherrer discussed BS&A cloud. Clare county is switching from .net to the cloud.
