REPEALER ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to Repeal Specific Township Ordinances

An Ordinance regulating the public health, safety, and welfare for Franklin Township; to repeal the specific ordinance outlined below that Franklin township previously adopted; and to provide this ordinance's effective date.

THE FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP BOARD(Clare County, Michigan) ORDAINS:

SECTION 1 Title

This ordinance is to be known and cited as the Franklin Township Repealer Ordinance
No. 109-25

SECTION 2 Purpose and Preamble

This Ordinance concerns and is to further the public health, safety, and welfare for Franklin Township; is to repeal the specific ordinance outlined below that Franklin Township previously adopted; and is to provide this ordinances effective date.

SECTION 3 Repeal of Specific Township Ordinances

This Repealer Ordinance repeals the ordinance (and any resolution adopted with those ordinances) that are listed below that the Township Board Previously adopted. The repeal does not affect or impair and act or omission; any offense committed; any right accruing, accrued or acquired; or any liability, penalty, forfeiture, or punishment incurred before the date of this Repealer Ordinance.

If any part of this Ordinance is declared invalid, that declaration does not affect the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

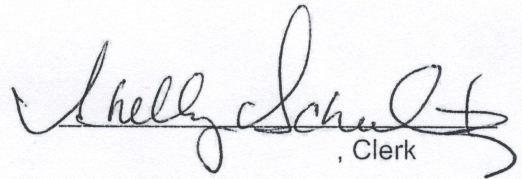
SECTION 5 Effective Date
